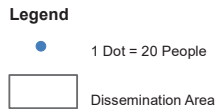
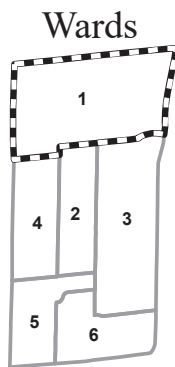
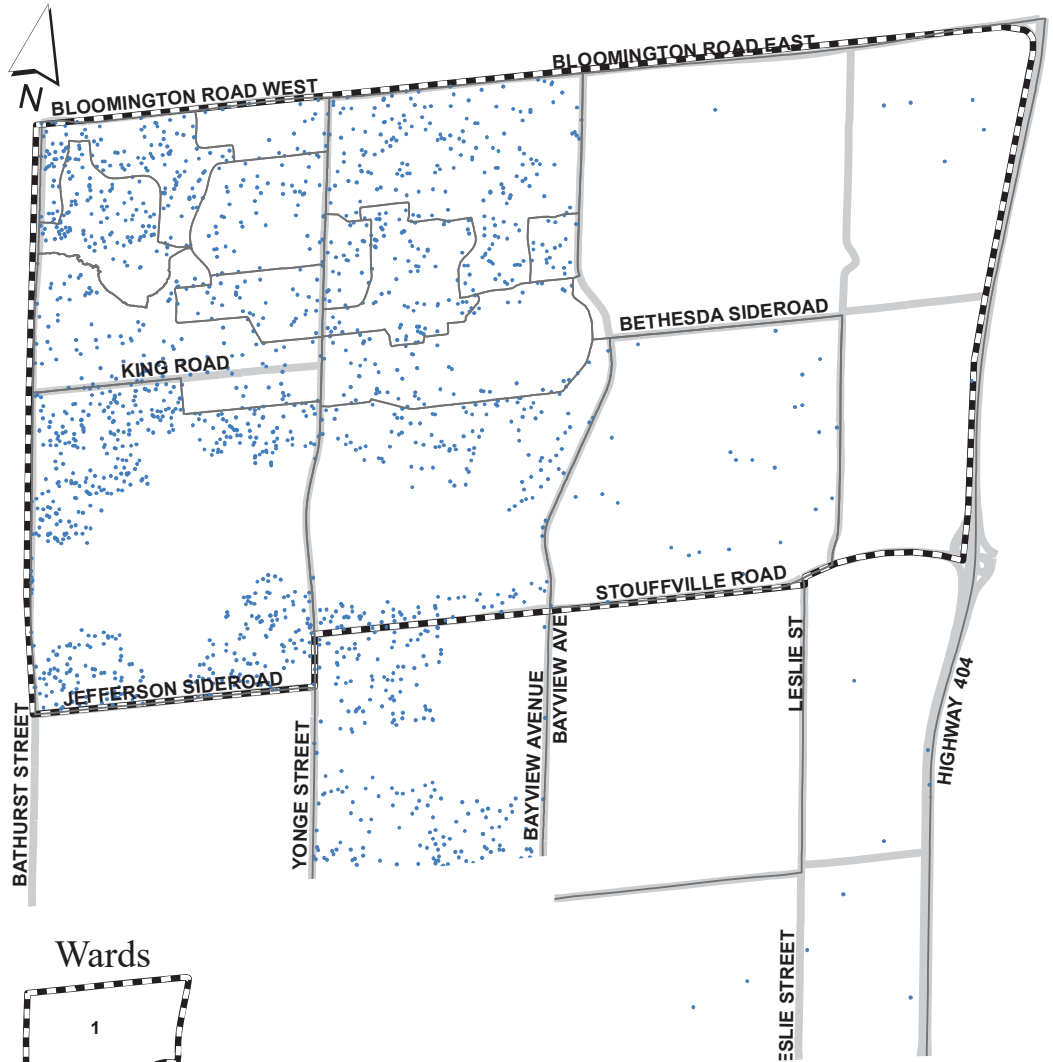
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Location & Density

The following map represents the population density for Ward 1 of the Town of Richmond Hill in 2011.

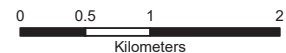
Please note that density is being represented across an entire dissemination area, not to the ward boundary.

2011 Population Density by Dissemination Area



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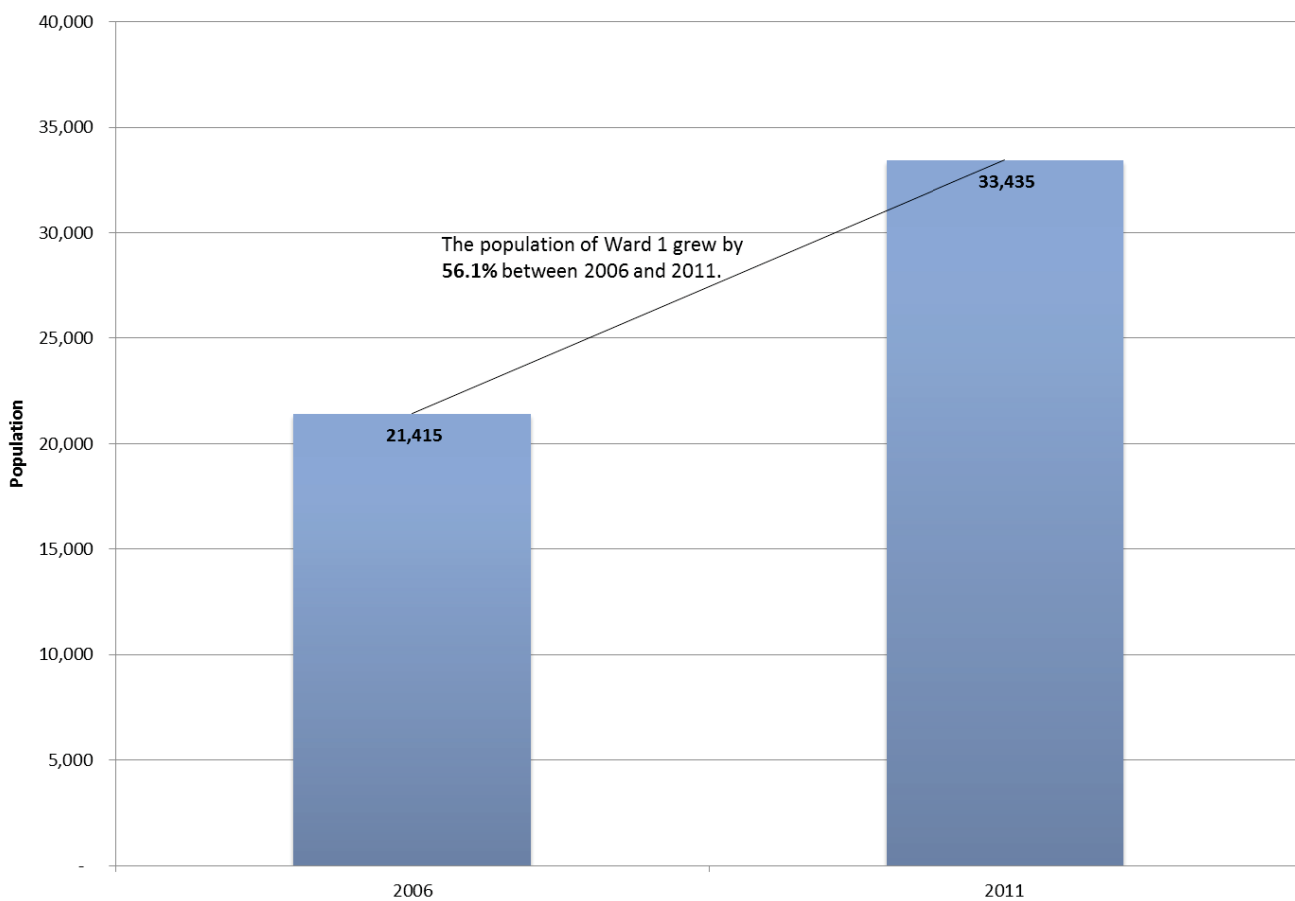

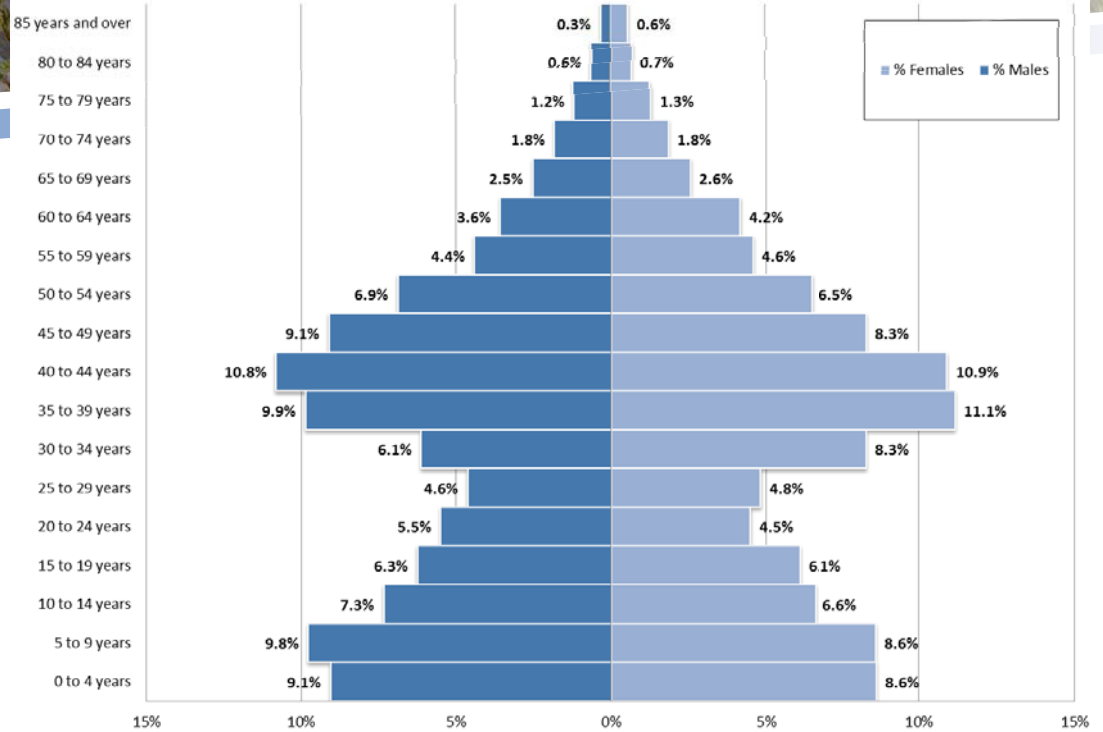
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Age

Ward 1 Population Pyramid (2011)

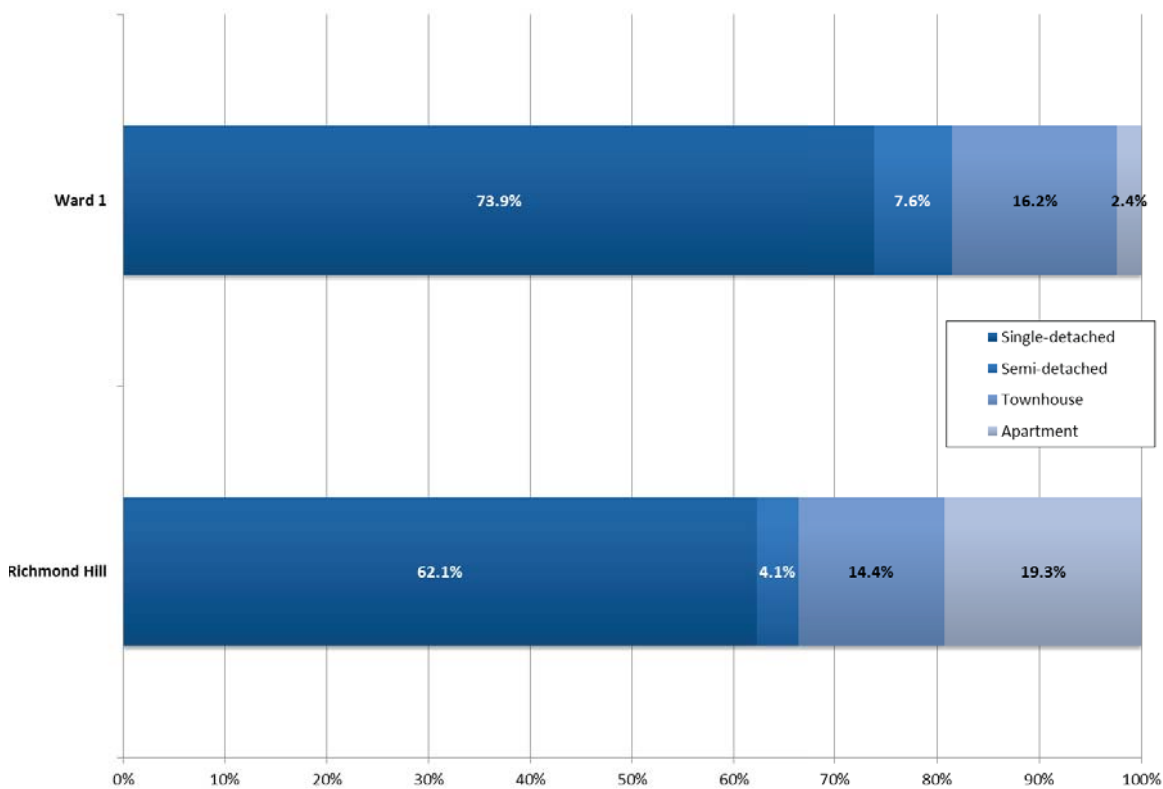

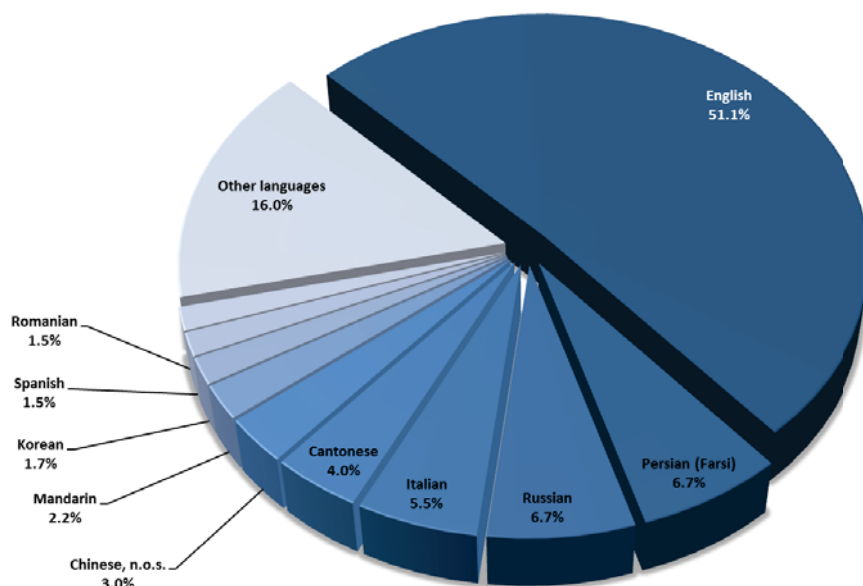
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Mother Tongue

Ward 1 Mother Tongue Languages (2011) - Single Responses

Mother tongue refers to the first language learned at home in childhood and still understood by the individual at the time of the 2011 Census.

The most common mother tongue language in Ward 1 is **English**, at **51.1%**.



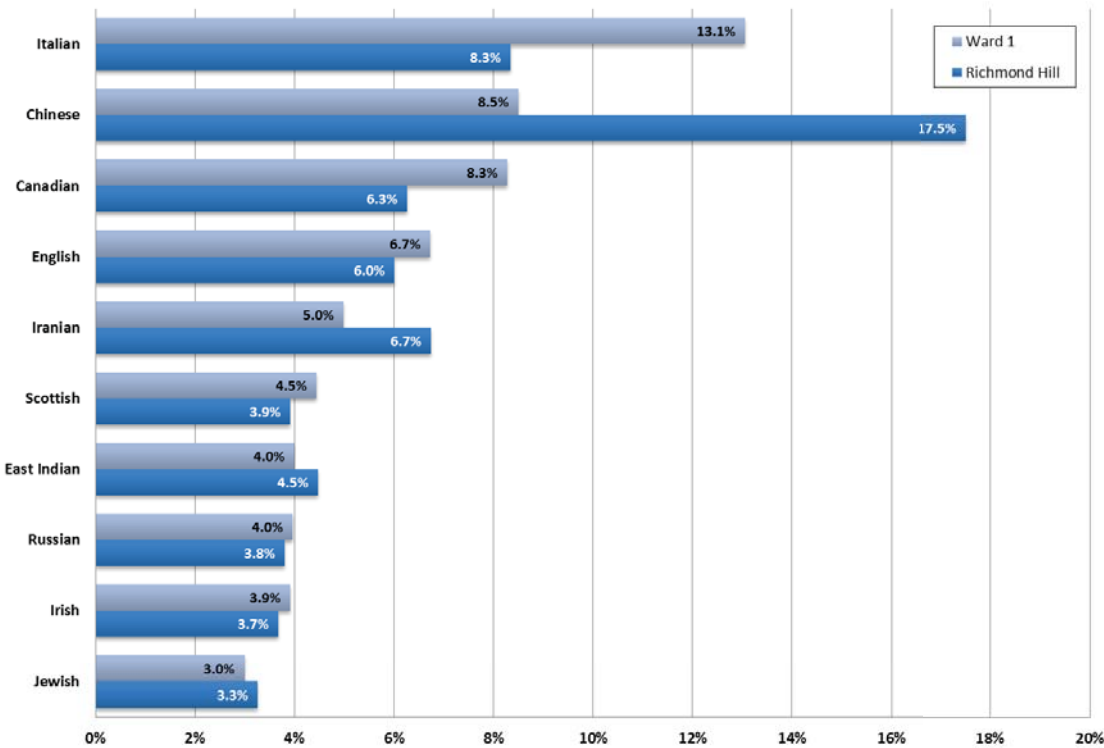

Note: Mother tongue information is based on single responses, using the same categorization as Statistics Canada for consistency in data reporting and analysis. However, it should be noted that when languages of a similar geographic or cultural origin (for example, Chinese and Chinese n.o.s.) are considered together, their impact on the ward total may be more significant than when analyzed separately.

Ethnic origin refers to the ethnic or cultural origins of the respondent's ancestors.

The most common ethnic origin in Ward 1 is **Italian**, at **13.1%** of the population.

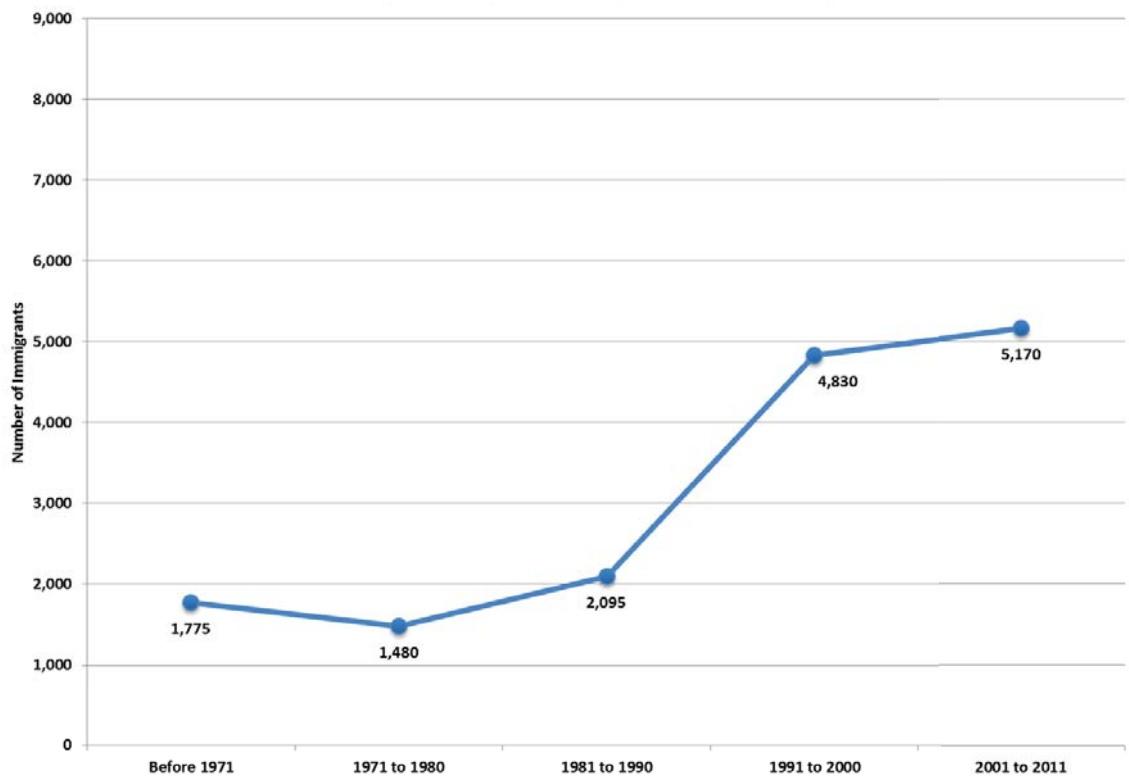

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Immigration Trends

Immigrant refers to a person who is or has ever been a landed immigrant/permanent resident. This person has been granted the right to live in Canada permanently by immigration authorities.

The majority of immigrants to Ward 1 arrived between the years **2001 to 2011**.

Since 2001, there have been **5,170** new immigrants to Ward 1.

Since 2006, there have been **2,080** new immigrants to Ward 1.

Note: The immigrant population figures by ward boundary correspond to the ward boundaries as they exist today, as such, caution should be used when comparing historical ward data with this data.

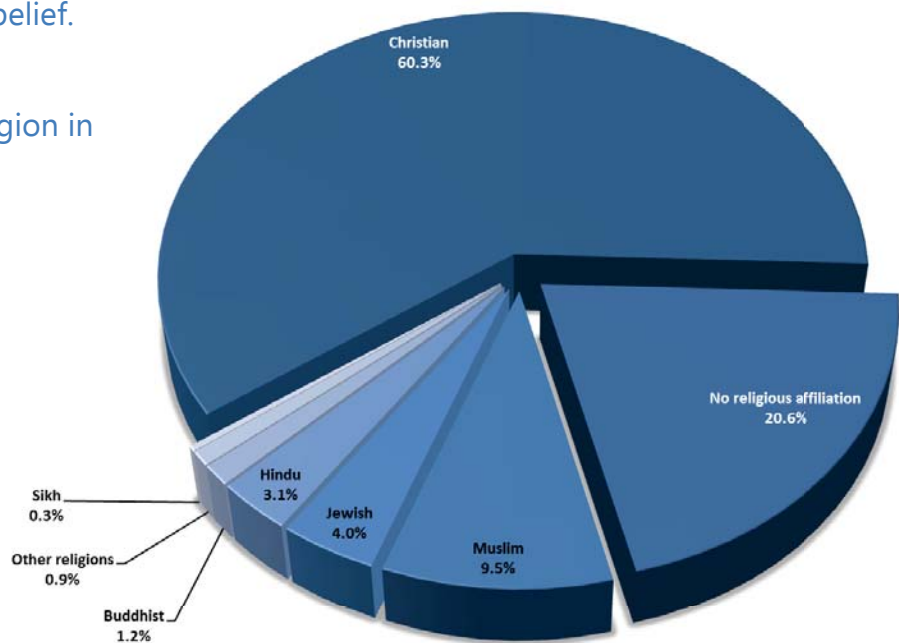
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Religion

Religion refers to the person's self-identification as having a connection or affiliation with any religious denomination, group, body, sect, cult or other religiously defined community or system of belief.

The most commonly reported religion in Ward 1 is **Christianity**, at **60.3%**.

Ward 1 Population by Religion (2011)

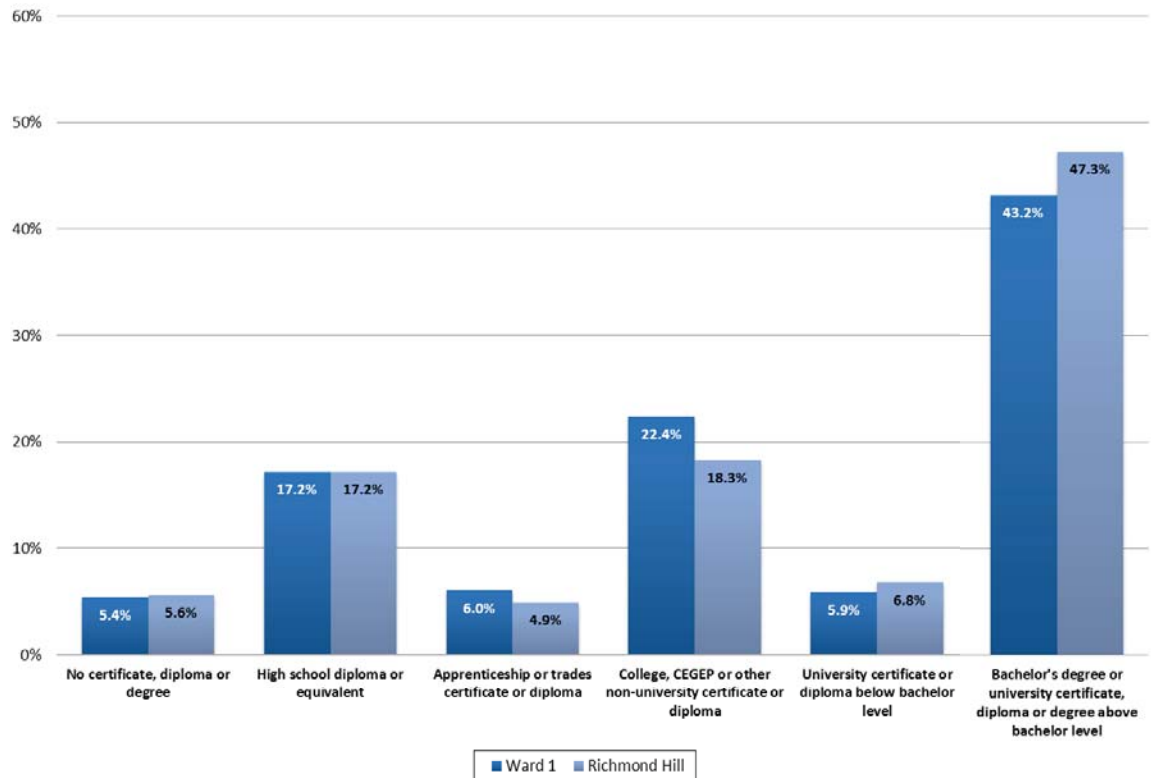

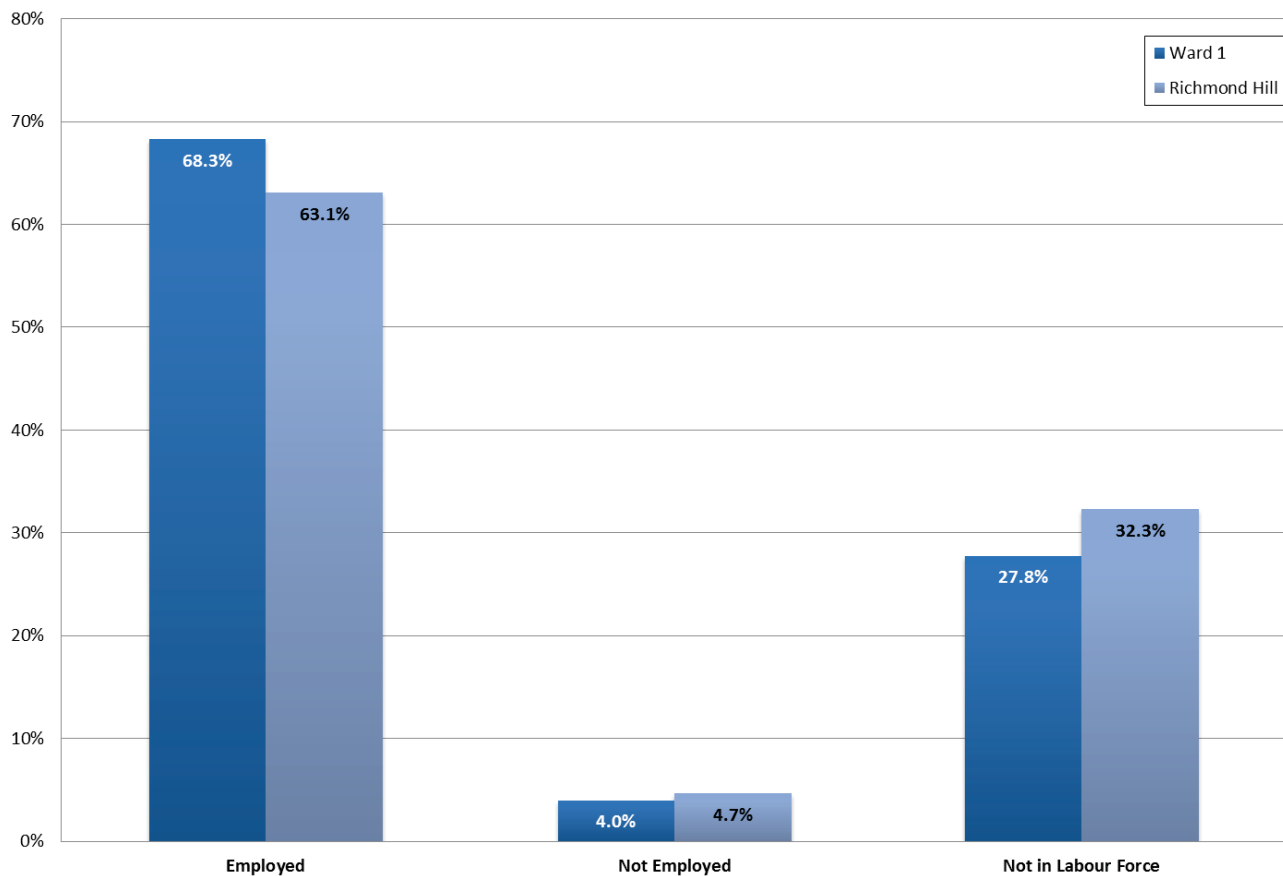
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Labour Force Status

Labour Force Status refers to whether a person was employed, not employed or not in the labour force during the 2011 Census reference week (Sunday, May 1 to Saturday, May 7, 2011).

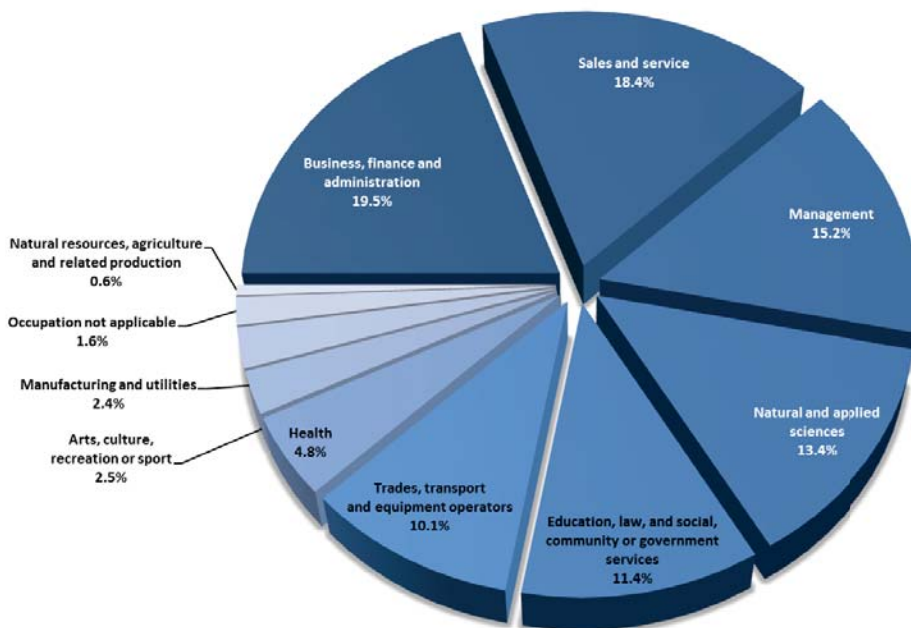

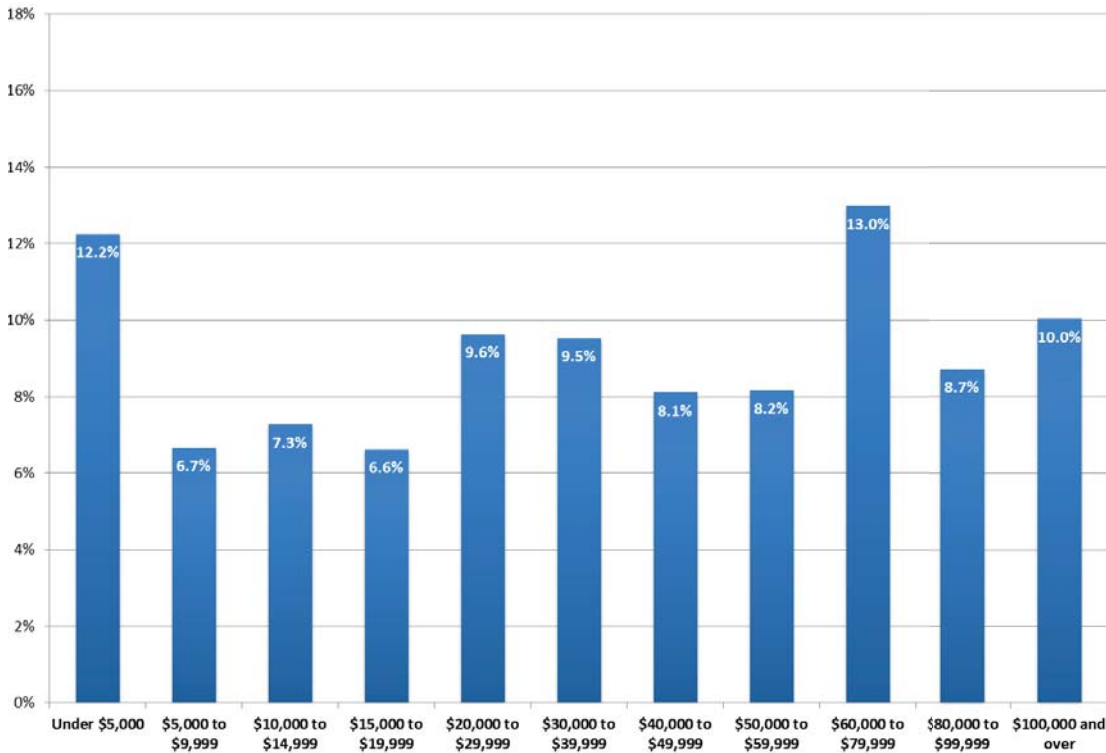

Ward 1 Total Income Distribution (2010)



Income refers to total income, before taxes, which is earned from all sources (including employment income, income from government programs, pension income, investment income and any other money income) by the population age 15 years and older, during the 2010 calendar year.

The Ward 1 average employment income for the population who worked a full year, full time is **\$69,824**.
