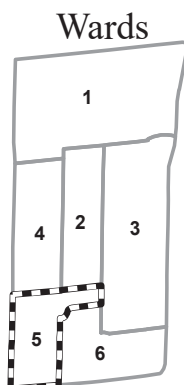
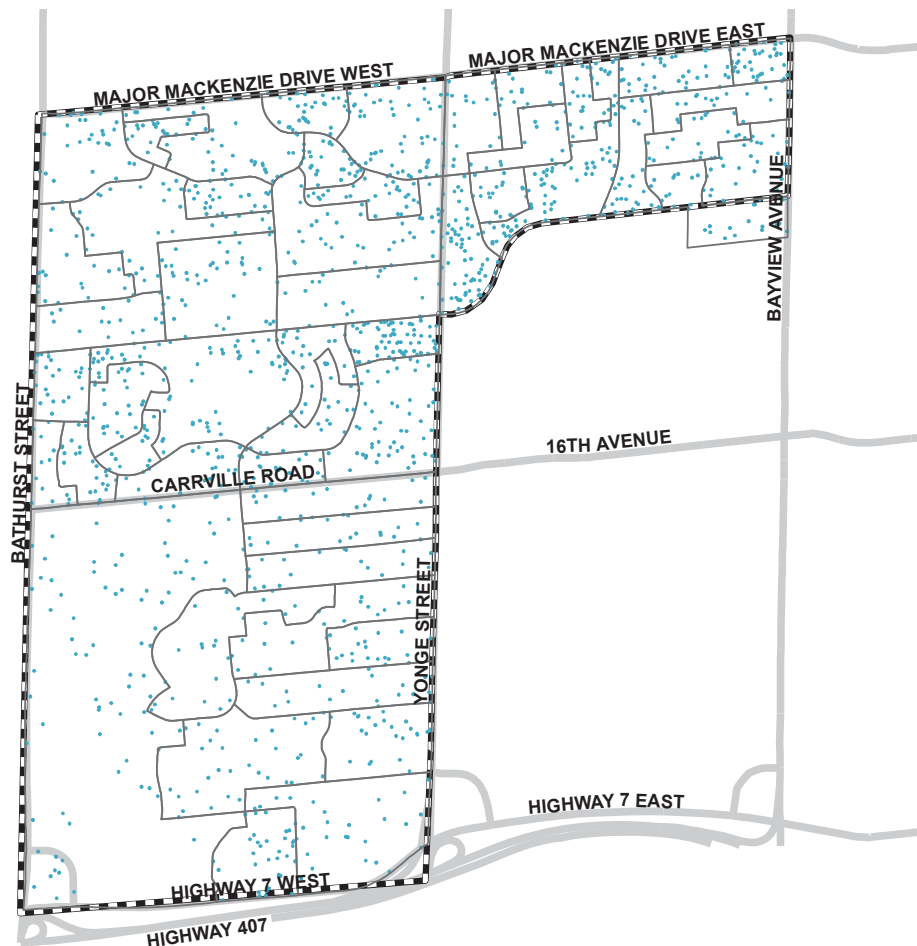
# WARD 5

Ward 5 is bound by **Major Mackenzie** to the North, **Yonge Street, Weldrick Road** and **Bayview Avenue** to the East, **Highway 7** to the South, and **Bathurst Street** to the West.

Please note that density is being represented across an entire dissemination area, not to the ward boundary.

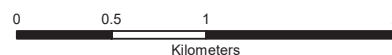

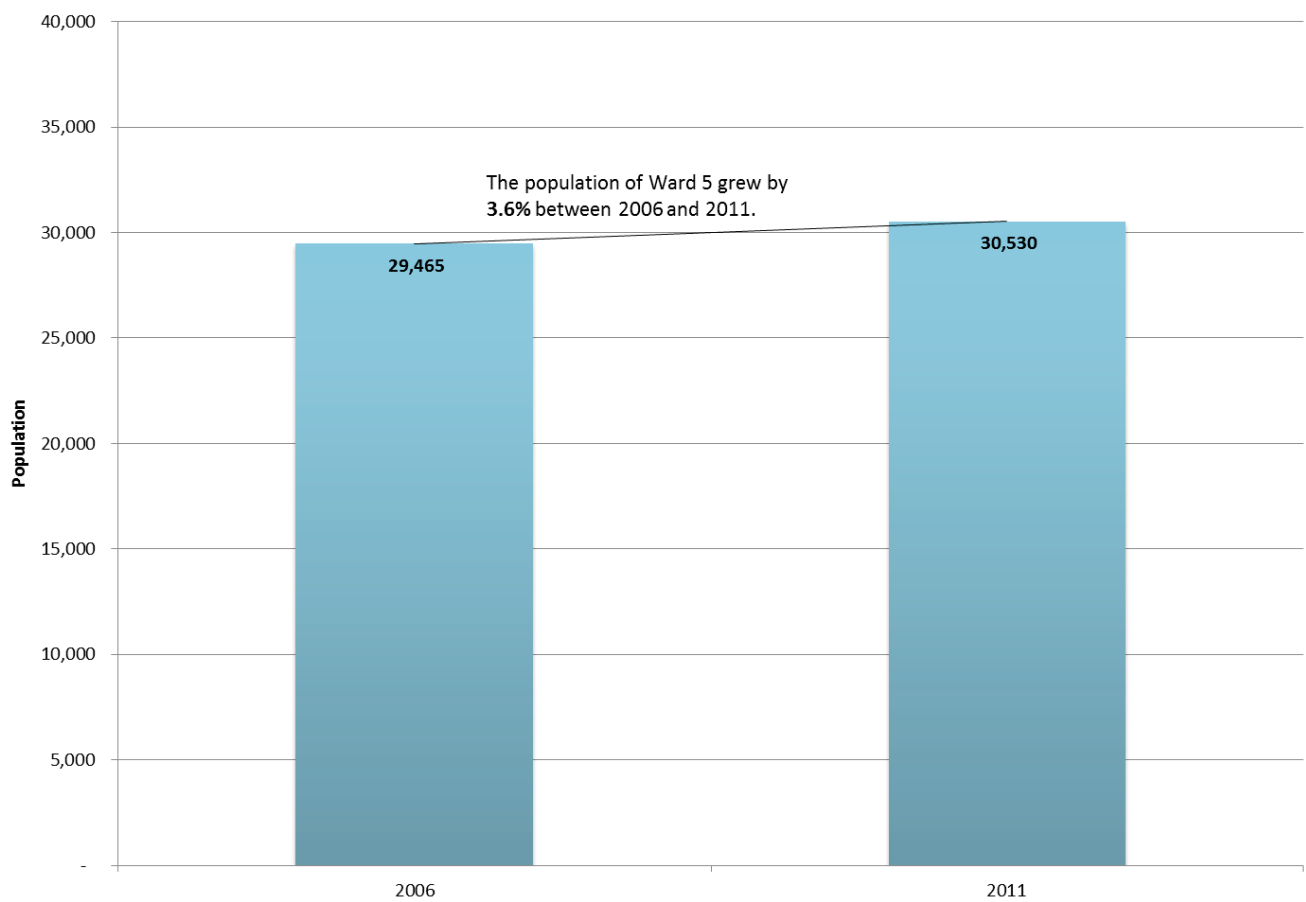

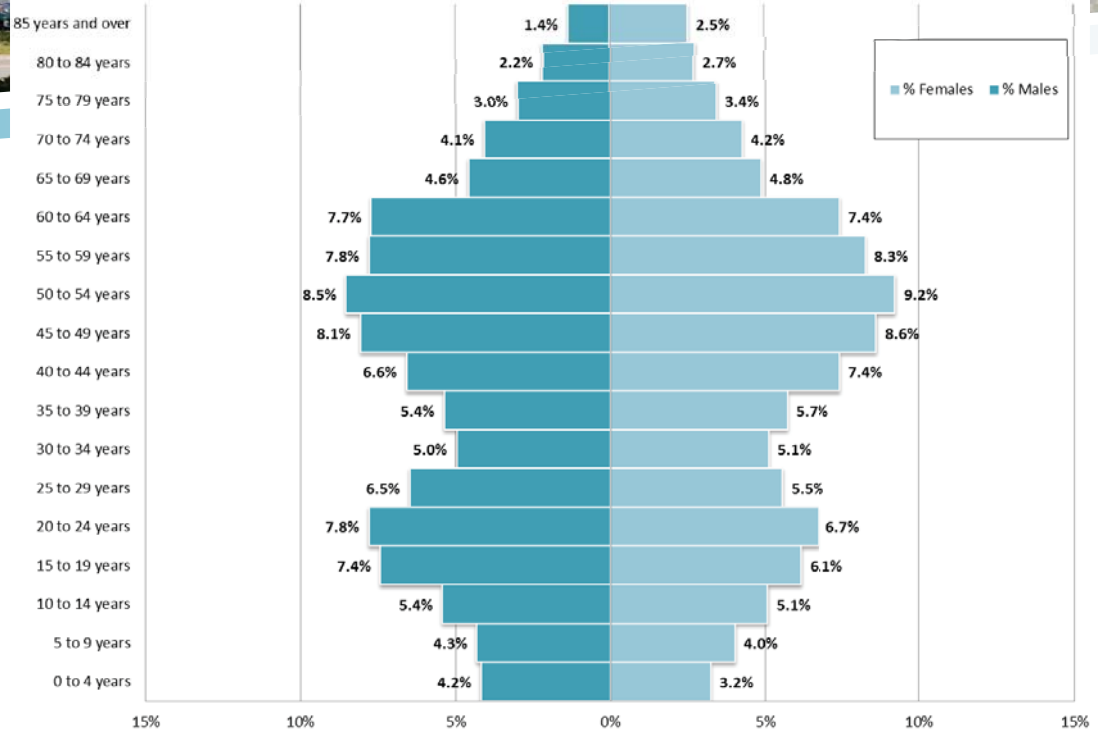
# WARD 5

Ward 5 Population Pyramid (2011)

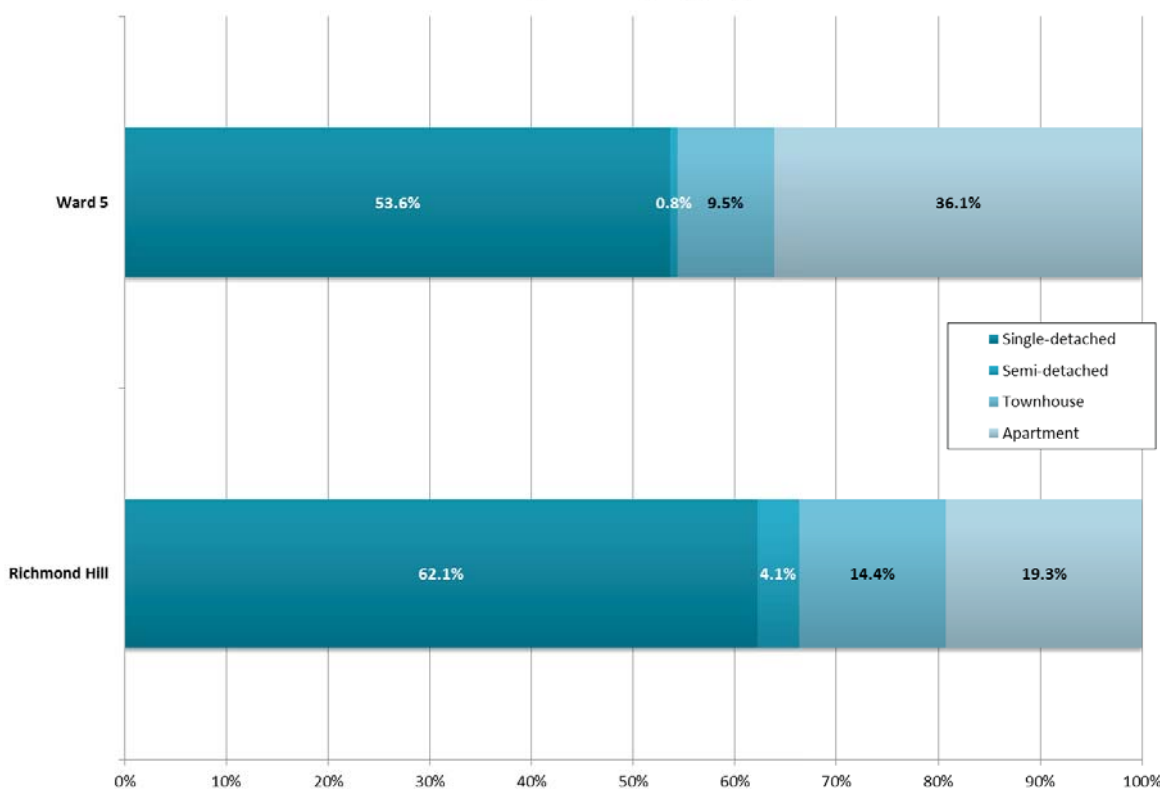

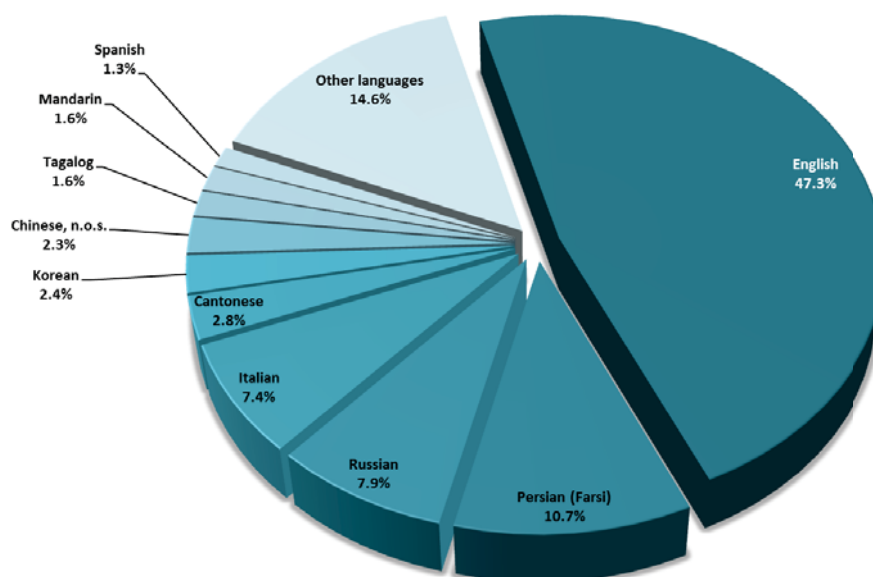

## Mother Tongue

The most common mother tongue language in Ward 5 is **English**, at **47.3%**.



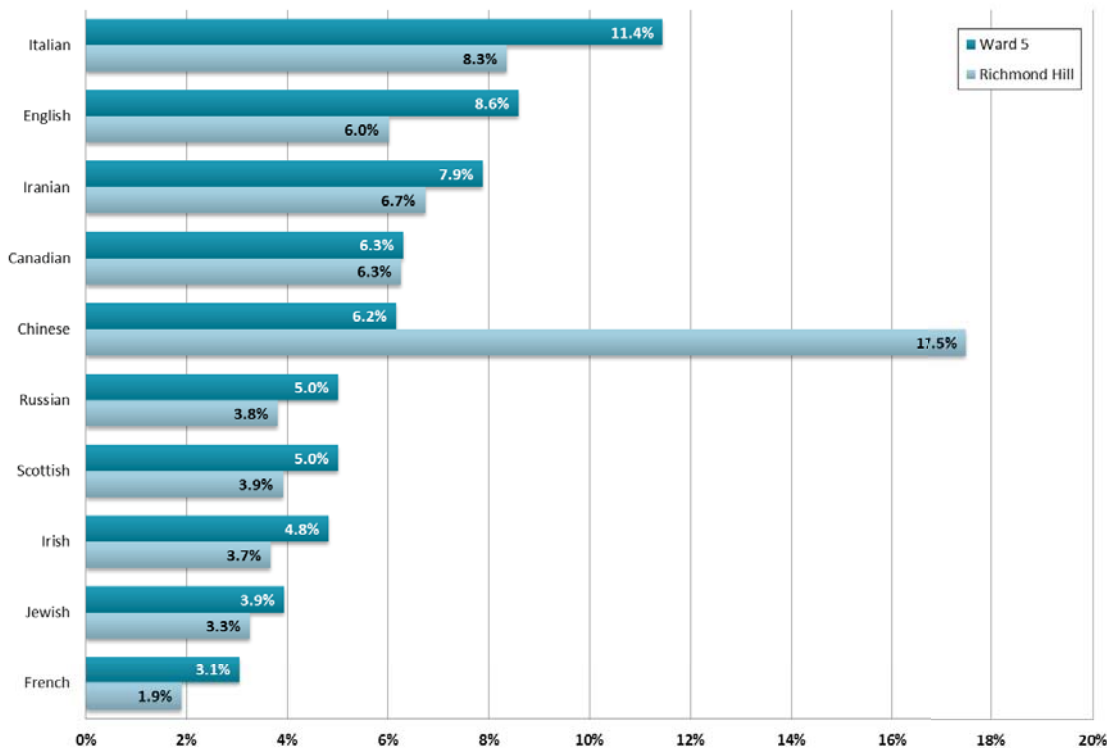

Note: Mother tongue information is based on single responses, using the same categorization as Statistics Canada for consistency in data reporting and analysis. However, it should be noted that when languages of a similar geographic or cultural origin (for example, Chinese and Chinese n.o.s.) are considered together, their impact on the ward total may be more significant than when analyzed separately.

## Ethnic Origin

**Ethnic origin** refers to the ethnic or cultural origins of the respondent's ancestors.

The most common ethnic origin in Ward 5 is **Italian**, at **11.4%** of the population.

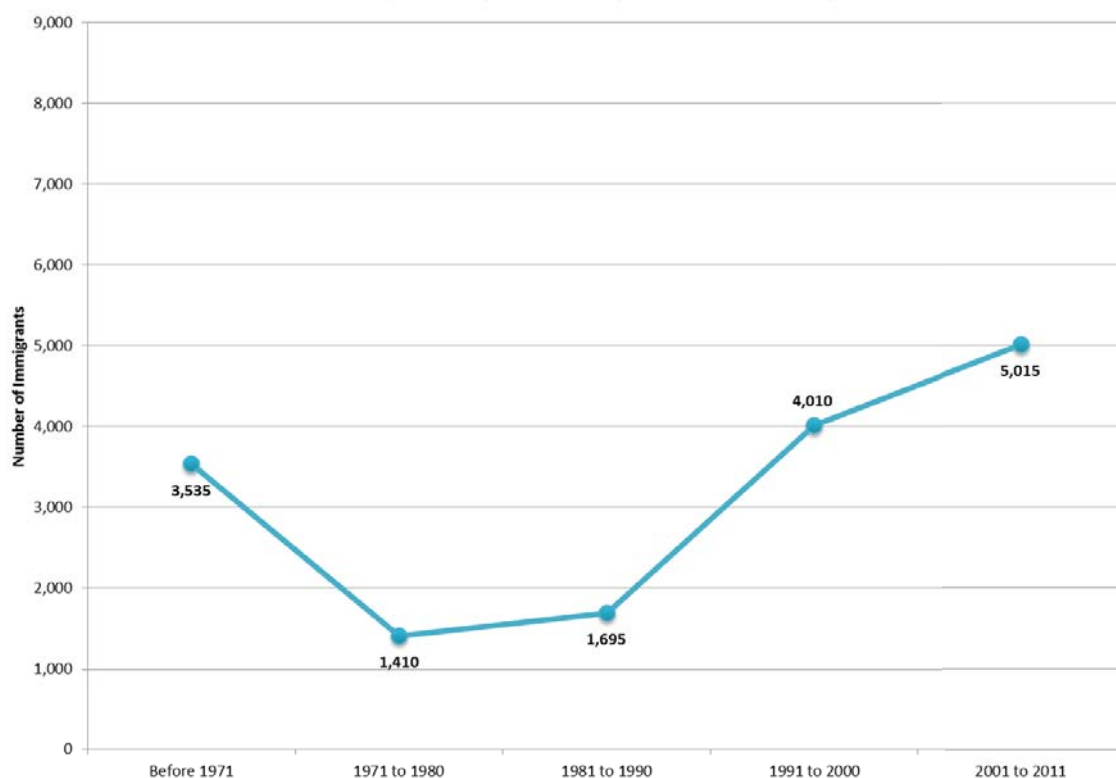

## Immigration Trends

**Immigrant** refers to a person who is or has ever been a landed immigrant/permanent resident. This person has been granted the right to live in Canada permanently by immigration authorities.

**Ward 5 Immigrant Population by Period of Immigration**



The majority of immigrants to Ward 5 arrived between the years **2001 to 2011**.

Since 2001, there have been **5,015** new immigrants to Ward 5.

Since 2006, there have been **2,225** new immigrants to Ward 5.

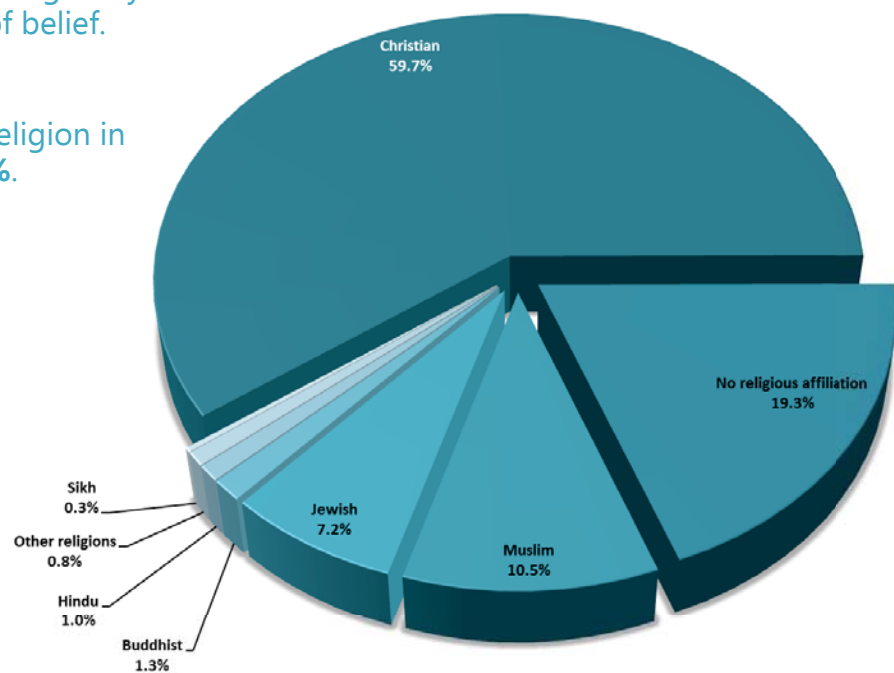
# WARD 5

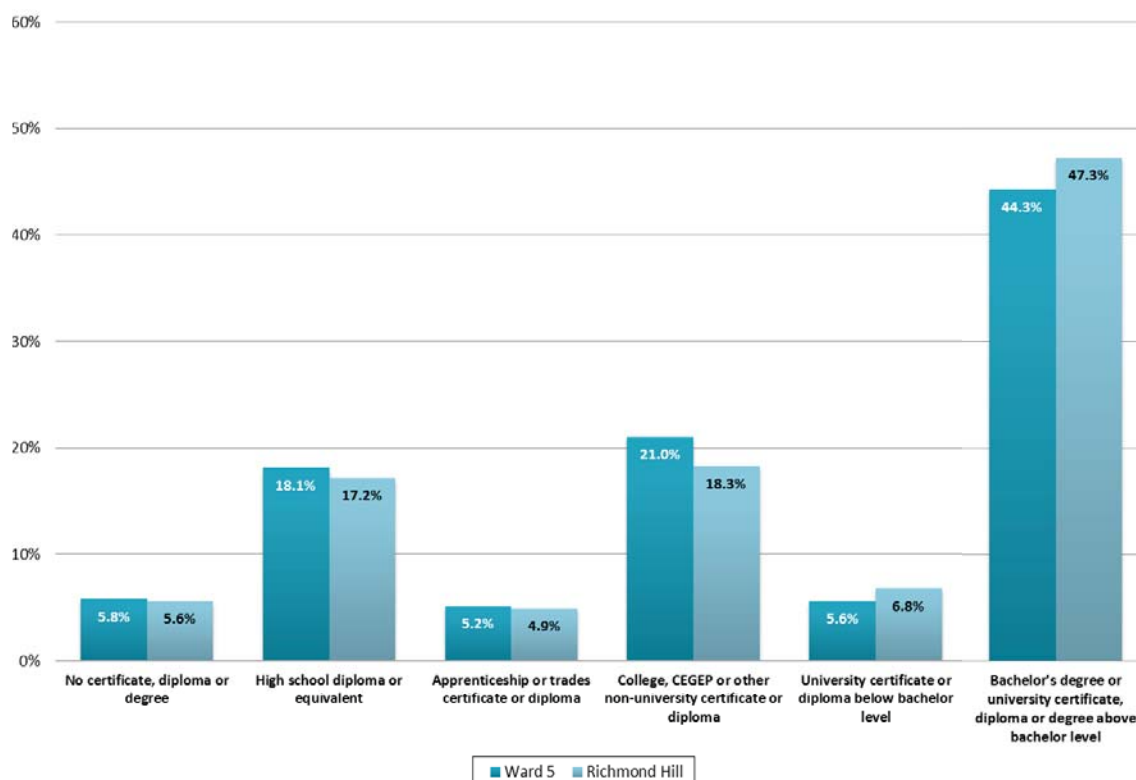

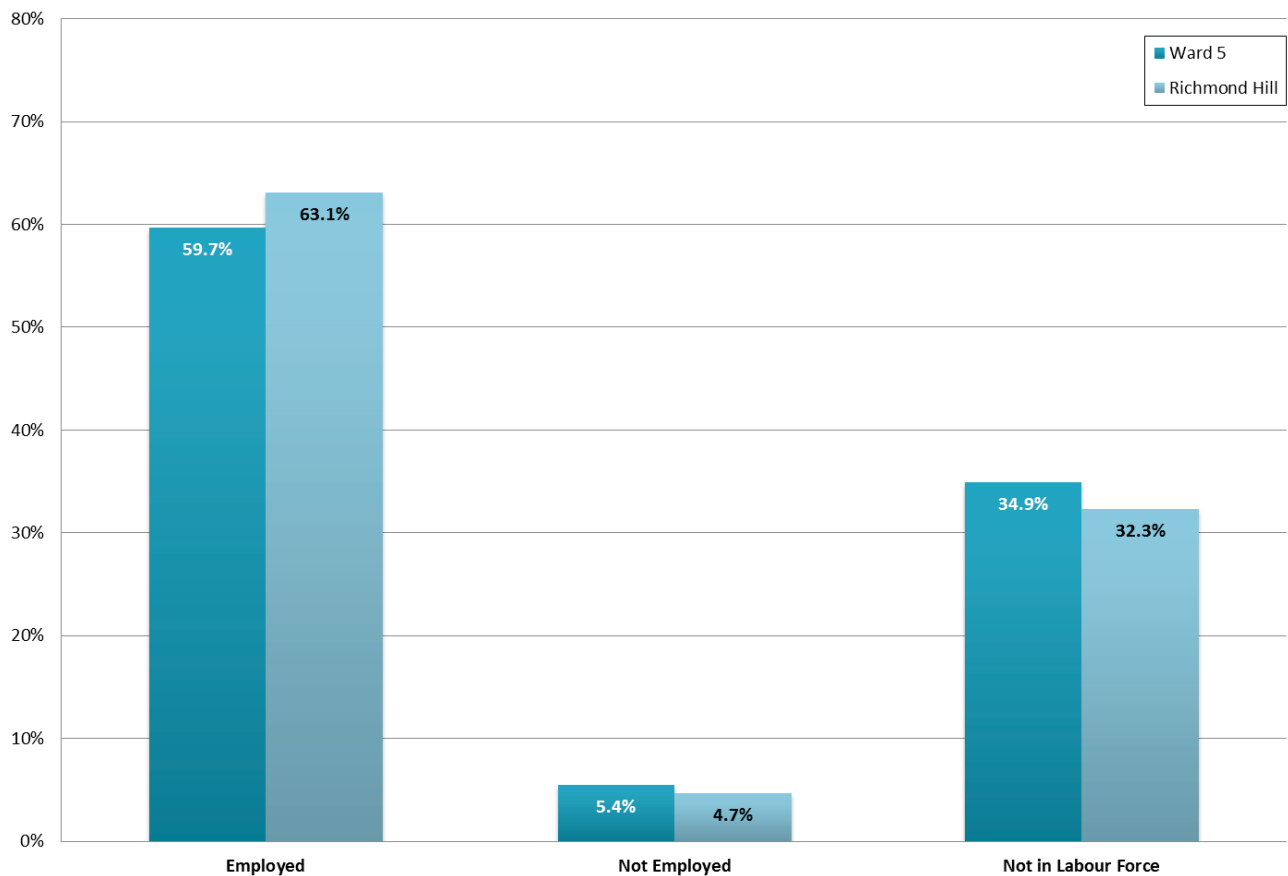
# WARD 5

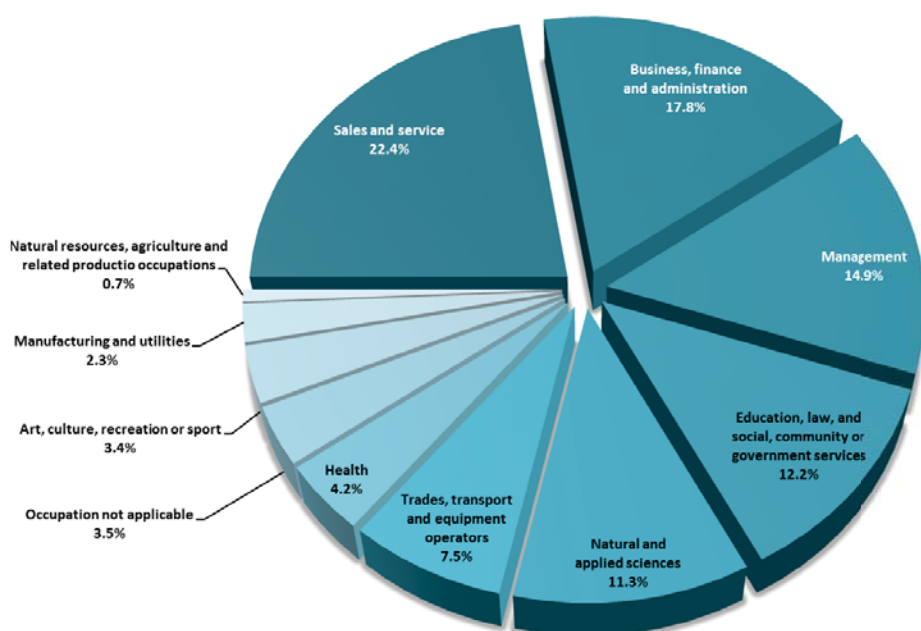

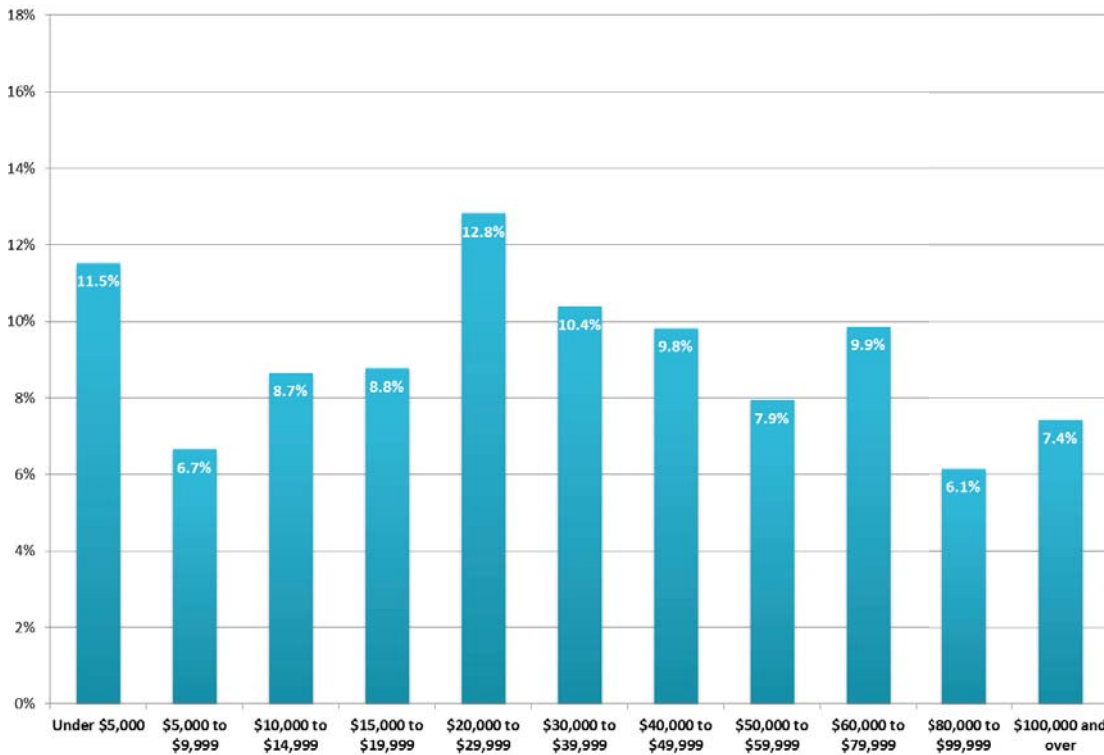

## Income

**Income** refers to total income, before taxes, which is earned from all sources (including employment income, income from government programs, pension income, investment income and any other money income) by the population age 15 years and older, during the 2010 calendar year.

The Ward 5 average employment income for the population who worked a full year, full time is **\$69,600**.
