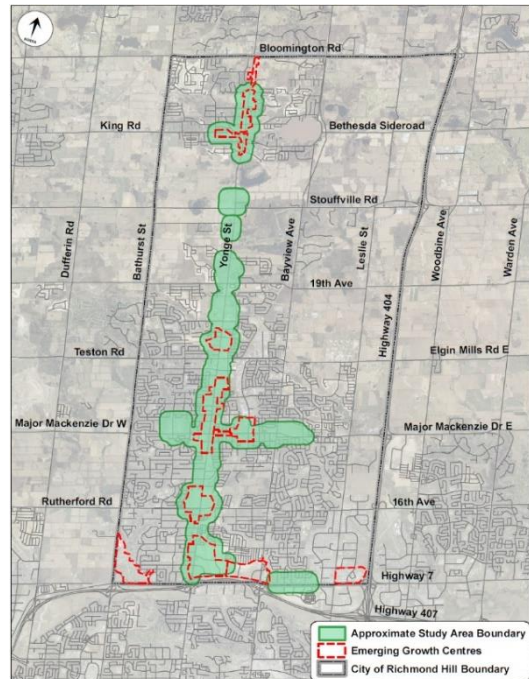


Urban Master Environmental Servicing Plan - Update Study

Notice of Completion – Environmental Assessment

STUDY OVERVIEW

The City of Richmond Hill has completed an update to the Urban Master Environmental Servicing Plan (UMESP) in support of the City’s Official Plan. The City has studied alternatives and determined that water and wastewater infrastructure upgrades are needed to support the planned growth within intensification centres shown in the accompanying map. This updated UMESP considered the municipal infrastructure needs of the community within the context of the new Official Plan, and established a feasible, sustainable, and innovative strategy that satisfies all applicable regulatory criteria.



PROCESS

The City of Richmond Hill in conjunction with Civica Infrastructure Inc. has completed the updated UMESP Study Report. The Study was conducted in accordance with the Master Plan process as outlined in the Municipal Engineers Association Municipal Class Environmental Assessment. A Public Information Centre (PIC) was held to provide master plan information as well as obtain feedback. Following input received from the PIC, review agencies and other key stakeholder consultation, the Class EA Study Report was completed to recommend a series of strategies and improvements in keeping with the project objective.

A Study Report documenting the planning process undertaken, key details of the study recommendations as well as potential impacts and mitigation measures, has been completed and is being made available for public review.
